“Sing a Song of Flowers”

(Sing to the tune “Sing a Song of Sixpence”)

Chorus:

Sing a song of flowers, flowers all around,
Flowers that are growing, growing in the ground,
Flowers of every color, they look so pretty too!
Red and pink, orange and yellow, blue and purple too.

1. Sing the chorus.
2. Ask the children if they see any flowers of those colors in the garden space? Help the infants and toddlers find the flowers and tell them the colors that they see.
3. Have them run and point to them.
4. Sing the chorus again.
5. Walk in a circle holding hands. Infants and toddlers can dance and move to the song.
6. Sing the chorus again.
7. Have paper and crayons of the six colors ready on a table for the children to color their own flowers, one of each color! Infants and toddlers can just enjoy the experience of coloring without matching colors.
